## Notable news & breaches

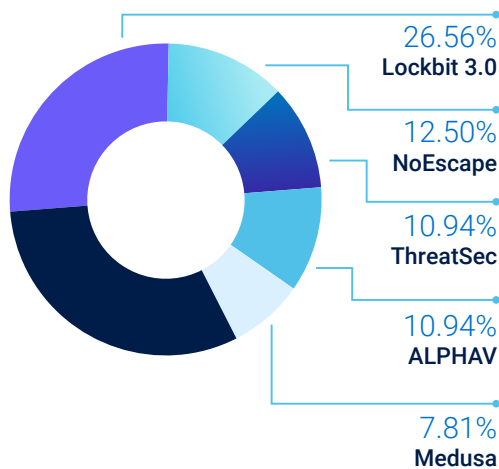
- Over 50% of United States ransomware incidents were municipalities with under 200 employees

## Noteworthy threat actor

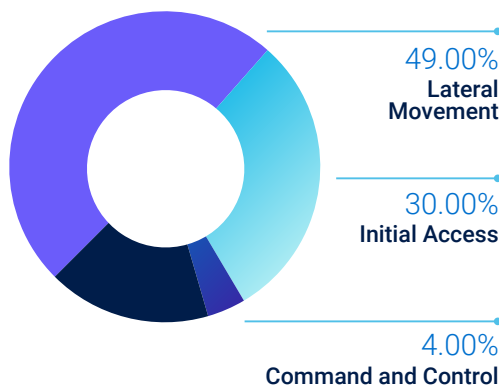
### ThreatSec

ThreatSec launched an extortion site in December 2023, listing data for several local governments. The group claims they are not financially motivated but aim to target governments they believe to be corrupt or oppressive.

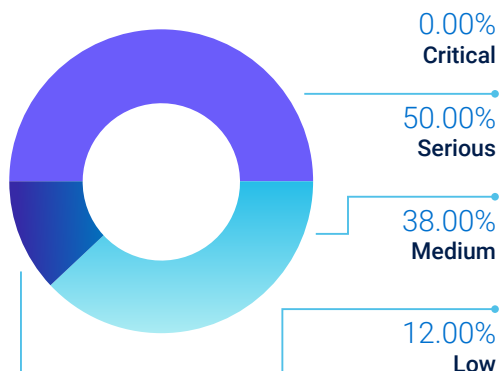
### Top ransomware



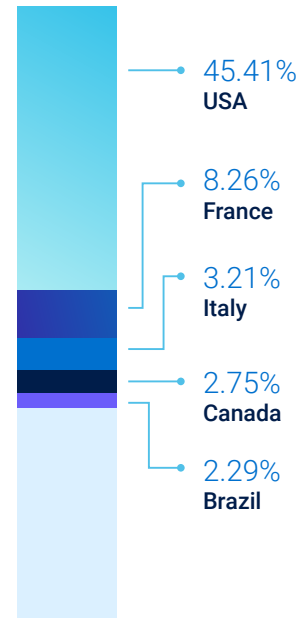
### Incident MITRE tactics
